POSSIBLE PLANTING PLAN

Planting area approx. 10m x 55m, running away from road/park south to north. Leave 1.5m gaps/paths through every now and then to allow watering and mulching access, with density of large trees and taller shrubs less toward eastern edge, with more medium shrubs in middle, leaving space (and light) for an edge of small shrubs, tussock grass and Lomandra along the east edge.

Large trees (Eucalypts, kurrajong, Casuarina), 5m apart, along creek (west) side 1m out from existing vegetation, then next line staggered to previous line 5m apart 3m out, then line staggered again further 3m out. Leaving 2-3m clear to east edge of planting.

Smaller trees and tall shrubs (wattles, bottlebrush, teatree), at least 3m apart, amongst larger trees, then thinner out towards Eastern edge.

Medium shrubs thinly planted along Western edge, more dense in middle, medium density to edge.

Low shrubs and grasses, to form an edge 2m or so deep along east edge, maybe in species clumps.
